# Tuition Rates Effective Fall Semester 2021

The College reserves the right to change tuition and other fees as deemed necessary. Incremental tuition increases are generally made at the beginning of the fall semester if applicable. A \$30.00 charge will be assessed for returned checks. Convenience fees may be assessed for online or credit card payments.

The College reserves the right to transition classes to an online format if circumstances warrant restricting or closing classrooms on campus. # **Entrance Fees**
