Thanks to a major capital investment, Riverside Smithfield Hospital has acquired **one of the most advanced cardiac CT scanners** available today—technology capable of detecting heart disease in seconds with stunning clarity and precision. This top-tier system includes critical diagnostic and safety-enhancing add-ons, ensuring our clinical team has the very best tools to serve our community.

Now, we're looking to complete the picture

What brings this powerful equipment to life—and directly benefits patients—are the technology packages that drive imaging interpretation, data management and care coordination. These include advanced software for Alassisted diagnostics, data archiving systems, secure image sharing for multidisciplinary teams and the technical infrastructure to fully integrate with electronic medical records.

While the equipment itself is in place, these supporting technologies require substantial funding to implement. That's where your partnership can make all the difference.

By helping fund the tools that turn cuttingedge hardware into life-saving care, you'll be:

Enhanced Services

Cardiac CTA can quickly detect coronary artery disease, congenital heart defects or other structural issues. This technology helps providers rule in or rule out heart disease with high confidence, often avoiding the need for invasive diagnostic imaging like cardiac catheterization which will not be offered at RSH. In the ED, cardiac CTA speeds up the evaluation for chest pain, reducing time to diagnosis and unnecessary admissions. If it is determined that a patient needs a higher level of care based on the outcomes of their cardiac CTA, we can quickly transfer them to Riverside Regional Medical Center where we have a full range of cardiac capabilities including – cardiac catheterization and open-heart surgery.

Community Impact

Local availability of cardiac CTA helps patients get answers faster and closer to home without waiting weeks for a referral or an appointment at a distant facility. This can lead to earlier intervention and better outcomes.
