### PHASE 1

#### PHASE 1A

##### HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS

including frontline caregivers, emergency responders and hospital cleaners; residents of long-term care facilities.



#### PHASE 1B

##### FRONTLINE ESSENTIAL WORKERS

in high-risk fields such as first responders, education, food and agriculture, manufacturing, corrections, U.S. postal service, grocery stores, and public transit and those 75 and older.



#### PHASE 1C

##### OTHER ESSENTIAL WORKERS


in fields such as transportation and logistics, food service, construction, finance, IT & communications, energy, media, legal, public safety, and water and wastewater; people 65 and older; and those with certain chronic medical conditions.



### PHASE 2

##### PEOPLE WITH MODERATELY HIGH-RISK MEDICAL CONDITIONS;

residents and staff in HOMELESS SHELTERS and GROUP HOMES; inmates younger than 65 in JAILS, PRISONS and DETENTION CENTERS.



### PHASE 3

##### YOUNG ADULTS AND CHILDREN

*(if the vaccine is determined safe for them);*

##### WORKERS IN INDUSTRIES

such as hotels, banking, higher education and manufacturing.



### PHASE 4

##### ALL OTHER U.S. RESIDENTS.
