



340B is a federal government funded drug pricing program that allows health systems like Riverside to purchase outpatient medications at significant discounts.

This allows us to further our mission to “care for others as we would care for those we love” — not only by offering critical care to patients who otherwise couldn’t afford it, but also supporting more comprehensive services and programs for our community.

That means more uninsured and underinsured people can access the care they need, resulting in healthier, more equitable communities.

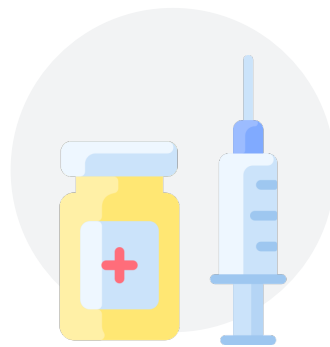

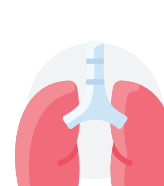
