FAQs for Multi-factor Authentication

Multi-factor Authentication, or MFA, adds an extra layer of security to your My Chart account. When MFA is enabled, we can verify your identity by sending you a security code to use along with your password when you log in. Even if someone has your account password, they won't be able to login and access your information without the extra security code.

Why are we implementing multi-factor authentication?

Cyber-attacks have increased enough to make headlines on an almost daily basis. Cyber-criminals are compromising user-ID and password combinations using phishing attacks that trick even the savviest of email users. Computers don't know when a password has been compromised, it just grants access to whoever enters it. An analysis of recent breaches shows that if there had been additional authentication factors, the breaches probably wouldn't have happened.

The data contained within the My Chart patient portal is highly confidential information that deserves the best protections that can be offered. Therefore, My Chart is implementing multi-factor authentication to better protect the information contained within your My Chart account.

What if I don't want to enable MFA?

For the security of your account and personal health information, it is optional; however, we encourage MFA.

How do I enable MFA?

You may also enable MFA from the My Chart Account Settings > Two-Step Verification. "Two-Step Verification" slide the toggle to "Turn On" and insert phone number. We'll send a code to your email or phone. Enter the code you receive into this app for verification. Once we verify your identity, you will be logged in.



What should I do if I don't receive a code or the code doesn't work?

If you do not receive a code, first make sure that the phone number you entered is correct. If the phone number is correct, click the "Resend code" button on the verification screen.
